Professional Leadership Attendance Network

Would you like to build your leadership skills and better engage your district team to improve student attendance?

Thanks to generous foundation funding, this year Attendance Works is able to offer enrollment in the Professional Leadership Attendance Network (PLAN) at a deeply reduced rate of \$3,000 per participant (normally \$10,000).

What is PLAN?

Over one year, a select group of administrators will have the opportunity to learn from each other, as well as experts, and develop a plan for action. Attendance Works will offer feedback on your district plan. PLAN is not a webinar series—it is an intensive, six-month professional network designed to equip district leaders with the tools and systems needed to effectively reduce chronic absence.

Highlights of PLAN

- **Six-Month Engagement**: Virtual sessions begin in mid-November and run consecutively for six months.
- **Focus on Systems and Infrastructure**: Build long-term district capacity to sustain attendance improvement.
- **Problem of Practice:** Each participant identifies and works on a critical attendance challenge unique to their district.
- **Strategic Planning:** By the end of the program, participants develop a Strategic Attendance Plan for the upcoming school year.
- **Collaborative Network:** Connect and learn with peers facing similar challenges across the country.

Sessions start in November 2025.
