

Making An IRA Qualified Charitable Distribution to Attendance Works

Why Qualified Charitable Distributions?

If you are age 70½ or older, you may be eligible to make Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCDs) directly from your traditional IRA to a qualified charity like Attendance Works, a project of Community Initiatives. Many donors also use QCDs to help meet their Required Minimum Distribution (RMD).

A QCD allows funds to be transferred directly to Community Initiatives/Attendance Works, which can be a meaningful way to support our mission. Some donors appreciate that **QCDs may have tax-related benefits**, depending on their personal circumstances.

Eligible individuals can donate up to \$105,000 per year directly from your IRA. Help us meet our goal of raising \$1,000,000 by June 2029 in individual donations by making a qualified charitable distribution!

How to make Qualified Charitable Distributions:

To make a gift from your IRA to Attendance Works, a project of Community Initiatives, contact your IRA administrator to arrange a direct transfer from your account. We strongly recommend you instruct your broker to include your name and address with the check. Your IRA administrator can send the funds by check made payable to Community Initiatives/Attendance Works (Community Initiatives is our fiscal sponsor). Alternatively, the check can be made out to Community Initiatives with Attn: Attendance Works in the memo line. The check can be mailed to:

For a QCD to be processed correctly, the transfer must go directly from your IRA account to Community Initiatives/Attendance Works. If the funds are first distributed to you personally, your IRA administrator may treat them differently. Please check with your IRA administrator or professional advisor for guidance on your specific situation.
